

GUIDELINES FOR POSTER DISPLAY

SPECIFICATION:

- The size of the poster should not exceed 85 cm (w) x 150 cm (h)
- Poster orientation must be portrait. Clear labels must be used for each section of the poster. Text should be of sufficient size for easy reading at a distance of one (1) meter.
- Title must be displayed clearly at the top of the poster and should include the names of the author(s) and the institution(s).
- Names of Authors:
 - All co-investigators should be listed using full last name and first name.
 - Last name should be capitalized.
 - The principal investigator should be identified with an asterisk * and the presenter's name underlined.
 - If you plan not to display your Abstract, please inform us as soon as possible.

DISPLAY INSTRUCTIONS:

- Authors must prepare all posters beforehand in a form such as light **white film** enabling easy mounting.
- Please be advised that the display of Abstracts will be random by who comes first fix first basis, starting from one side, next, and then next, then next, until the end of one side, then continue to the not leave gaps between abstracts.
- Authors are responsible for affixing and removing their posters during the conference.
(Must be tidy using double adhesive)
 - Affixing Start Date: **Wednesday, 14 January 2026 - After 17:00 (Maybe Earlier)**
 - Removal Date: **Saturday, 17 January 2026 - Before 21:00**
- Poster displayers are advised to be available to discuss their posters with the conference participants and during the tour by Members of the Scientific Committee during coffee breaks.
- The organizing committee will not be liable for poster loss or damage.
